

## JLG NORTHEAST STUDY AREA

This study area includes the neighborhoods of Cadillac Heights, North Campau, Campau/Banglatown, East Davison Village, Grixdale Farms, and Greenfield Park.





## PRIORITIES:

- 1. Housing Affordability
- 2. Neighborhood Improvements, Connectivity and Beautification.
- Creating Jobs, Supporting Businesses & Building Wealth

#### What can be BUILT ON?

- Historic neighborhood with notable landmarks, assets and residents.
- Loyal and diverse community.
- Existing gardens and beautification efforts.
- Room for growth: enthusiasm for community investment.
- Walkability and accessibility.

## What is a CHALLENGE?

- Noise pollution and health concerns (proximity to expressway).
- Crime, safety and need for mental health resources.
- Littering and illegal dumping.
- Language barriers with residents and little community involvement.
- Fears of gentrification.
- Lack of street/open space maintenance and neglect:
  - Need for more city support.
  - Dead trees.
  - Poor sidewalk condition.
  - Solar street lights.
  - Vandalism.

## What are your HOPES & VISION?

- Family-friendly homes.
- More local small businesses.
- Historic recognition.
- More beautification and green space/recreation opportunities.
- Reduce blight.
- More City support.
- Increased equality and cultural unity.
- Renovated/redeveloped rec centers and playgrounds.
- Increased programming.
- Making the Northeast a destination.
- Increased pedestrian safety and access to public transit and bikeshare.

i.e. building stabilization, beautification grants

i.e. opportunities to downzone to light industrial, strategic tree planting and buffering

i.e. pop-up ready vacant lots, better connections to the JLG

### **CONNECT RESIDENTS TO JOBS**

i.e. vacant building reuse, supporting new business along the greenway, training programs

**Example Area Strategies:** 

 Focus greening enhancements (trees and planters) of the JLG on Joseph Campau from the Davison School to Halleck.

- Better connect Joseph Campau to SNF Corridor Conant on community identified streets Lawley and Halleck.
- Support Sylhet Farm to expand their produce stand facilities on Joseph Campau as a catalyst for more commercial activity.





### **IMPROVE BIKE ACCESS**

i.e. bike to work programs, slow streets connections to the JLG

### **SAFE PEDESTRIAN CONNECTIONS**

i.e. improve sidewalks, bike lanes, programming

### **ACCOMODATE CAR ACCESS**

i.e. on-street parking, parking lots at major access points

### **REDUCE CONFLICTS**

i.e. road rightsizing, crossing enhancements




### **IMPROVE TRANSIT ACCESS**

i.e. landlord outreach and incentives, code enforcement

### **IMPROVE HOUSING QUALITY**

i.e. home repair grants, low interest financing







i.e. Leverage public land and grants for new construction, expand targeted multifamily areas







### **BEAUTIFICATION**

i.e. public art, partner collaborations, tree plantings

### **COMMUNITY ACTIVATION**

i.e. pop-up market, community garden



### **ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH**

i.e. vacant lot clean-up and maintenance, demolition of hazardous structures




## NEIGHBORHOOD INFRASTRUCTURE
