




# JLG Northwest STUDY AREA

# What is a CHALLENGE?

- <u>Housing conditions and</u> <u>affordability:</u>
  - Vacant lots and neglected homes.
  - Slumlords
  - Fear of gentrification and displacement.
- <u>Street conditions:</u>
  - Poor lighting.
  - Dumping and irregular recycling pick-up.
  - Lack of signage/wayfinding.
- <u>Livability + Quality of life:</u>
  - Traffic, noise and air pollution.
  - Poor quality schools.
  - Slow internet.
  - Lack of healthy restaurants and fresh food access.
  - Cost of services.

# FLEX/ LIGHT INDUSTRIAL Building typology

### DESCRIPTION

- Modern industrial buildings that consist of flexible subdividable spaces
- Allows for scalability to accommodate the needs of different industrial business types
- Can work on a range of different site sizes across JLG neighborhoods
- New product for small to mid-size businesses 4,000-5,000 sq. ft. to 10,000-12,000 sq. ft.






