


# 8 WEEK TRENDS as of 07/23/24

## **COVID-19 CASE RATE**

The 7-day average rate of new confirmed COVID-19 cases among City of Detroit residents is 18.8 daily cases per million people as of 07/08/2024. This has increased compared to the previous report, when it was reported as 17.2 cases per million people.



## **COVID-19 EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT DIAGNOSES**

There are 0.7% of Emergency Department visits in Detroit with diagnosed COVID-19 as of 07/20/2024.




Figure 2: Syndromic Surveillance COVID-19 Diagnoses

### **COVID-19 INPATIENT BEDS**

There are currently 17 COVID-19 occupied inpatient beds and 5 COVID-19 occupied ICU beds recorded in the city of Detroit.





Figure 3: COVID-19 hospital occupancy

## **COVID-19 WASTEWATER MONITORING**

Wastewater monitoring shows 41% of sampling sites have detectable levels and 14% of sites have high levels of SARS-CoV-2 markers as of 07/16/2024 in the city of Detroit.

 The proportions are out of 22 sites across the city of Detroit from which wastewater samples are taken and tested for SARS-CoV-2 markers. Each sampling site represents a specific population based on the area its sewer shed covers, such as long-term care facilities, college dormitories, and entire ZIP code areas. Detectable levels are over 1000 copies/100mL; high levels are over 5000 copies/100mL.
