Please see Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) construction updates and maps below.

What's Happening in the Neighborhood?

Major Contracting will continue road and lawn restoration before cold weather arrives.

Street Restoration

Major Contracting crews are restoring pavements, driveways and sidewalks on several streets. This work will occur through the next few weeks and will be followed by lawn and sprinkler system repairs. This work is happening on:

- W Parkway between Parkland and Tireman
- Lamphere between Parkland and Tireman
- Dacosta between Parkland and Sawyer

Lawn and Sprinkler Repair

On streets where roadwork is complete, the contractor is performing lawn restoration and sprinkler repair. This work is happening on:

- Beaverland, Bramell, Tireman, and Chatham
- Parkland between Tireman and W Warren (Work related to the water main replacement project being completed by DWSD's contractor LGC.)

Spring 2025 Work


Storm sewer installation on Dolphin and Tireman will begin in early spring of 2025 once temperatures start to warm.


- Dolphin between Sawyer and Tireman

What's Happening in Rouge Park?

Contractors continue to work on final grading, topsoil placement and seeding around the south basin in Rouge Park. Planting of the remaining plants and trees will occur in the fall, along with continued maintenance of the prairie grass and flowers.

Additional maintenance and supplemental planting work will also occur in the spring of 2025. Following the completion of this, the bike path along the east shoulder of Outer Drive will be restored to ensure that construction activity does not damage newly placed pavements.
