On behalf of the Board of Police Commissioners, Chair Darryl Woods issued the following statement about the Officer-Involved Shooting on Monday:

“The Board of Police Commissioners extends concern and care to the Detroit Police Department and its law enforcement family on the extraordinarily tragic and traumatic events on Monday. We join with the Detroit community in praying for the recovery of the two wounded officers, for the deceased officer and his loved ones, and for healing for everyone during this very difficult time.

“We will continue to work with the Department and the Mayor to support expanded options for emotional and mental health services for all police officers.”
