## **Public Facility Rehabilitation and Public Infrastructure**

Through the Public Facility Rehabilitation (PFR) program, HRD uses CDBG funding to address the needs of Detroit residents who utilize public facilities such as community centers, senior centers, and homeless shelters.

The PFR program is designed to provide funding to nonprofit organizations that operate these public facilities and may not have access to the resources required to complete needed rehabilitation. Typical PFR projects include roof replacements, bathroom rehabilitation, and ADA accessibility updates.

The PFR program recently completed a roof replacement and a renovation of 4 bathrooms at the Latin Americans for Social and Economic Development (LASED) located at 7150 W. Vernor.
