

BUDGET SEASON

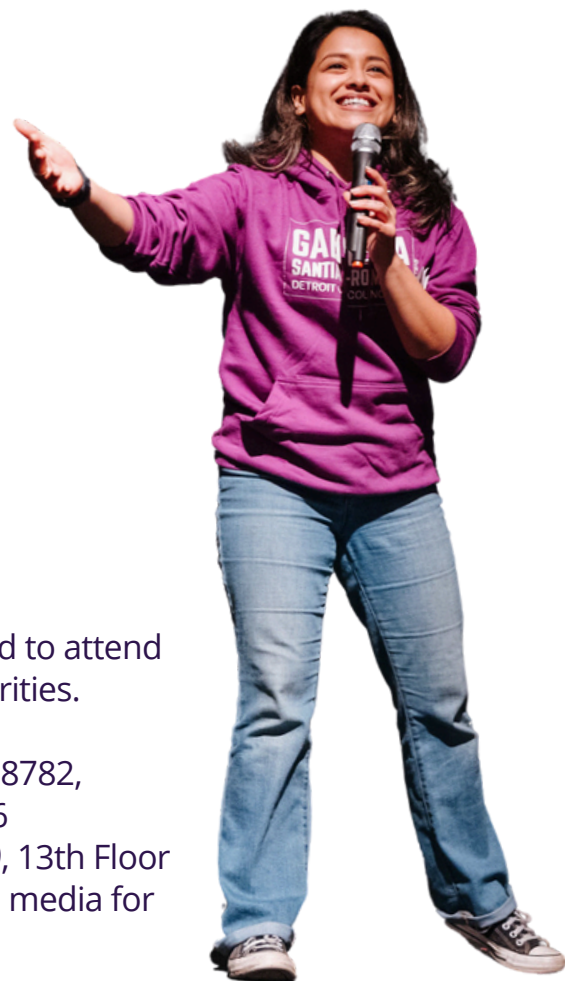
The City's fiscal year is July 1 - June 30. On March 7, the City will formally commence the annual budget process with the Mayor's budget address. Thereafter, City Council will begin budget hearings. Below are key dates for your planning:

1. March 7: Mayor's Budget Address to Council
2. March 13-28: Departmental Budget Hearings at City Council
3. March 31: Public Hearing on Budget
4. March 31 - April 6: City Council Executive Sessions on Budget
5. April 7: City Council votes on Budget
6. April 11: Mayor's Veto, if applicable
7. April 15: City Council Veto Override, if applicable

All meetings and hearings are open to the public. You are encouraged to attend and participate by making public comment to voice your budget priorities.
