

### **Sidewalk Repair | Phase 1**

- The sidewalk work on Beatrice,
   Miami, and S. Deacon was
   completed prior to the end of
   2024
- The following quantities have been worked upon:
  - 4" Sidewalk = 15,507 sq.ft
  - o 6" Sidewalk = 5,474 sq.ft
  - Sidewalk Removal = 20,979 sq.ft



# Slow Streets Improvements | Traffic Calming Interventions

#### **Median Islands**

- The proposed Median Islands are equipped with vertical pedestrian safety features like delineators
- These islands help calm traffic and reduce speed, promoting safer road conditions for all roadway users
- Delineators and yellow striping improve pedestrian visibility, especially at night or in low-light conditions





#### Chicanes

- The proposed Chicanes will aid the driver to navigate through the curves, naturally slowing down traffic
- These chicanes are a series of shifts in the road alignment to reduce vehicle speeds and improve safety
- The chicanes are equipped with vertical elements such as delineators and advanced signage notifying motorists that a lane shift is ahead






### **Healthy Streets**

- Healthy Streets are a combination of Painted Curb Extensions, Concrete Bumpers, and Slow Street Signage
- The Healthy Streets Intervention is proposed at the Beatrice St and Visger St intersection with Piwok Park being the landmark.
- This intervention narrows the roadway so motorized are encouraged to decrease their speed


