ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

The proposed streetscape project at Kercheval Avenue and Ashland Street could include lighting, sidewalk improvements, traffic calming, utility work, landscaping, trees, and site furnishings. The total estimated design and construction costs of this project is \$1 million.

DPW anticipates construction to begin in September 2025 and to be completed in Nov 2025.


