

Project Background

The City of Detroit has a Parks & Recreation Strategic Plan that outlines how to equitably fund improvements across our 300+ park system (more info at detroitmi.gov/parksplan) - and Cass Park is in the current phase for improvement!


The City has \$2.5 million for this project. We anticipate this may be enough for a significant first phase of improvements.


