# Heilmann Park: Project Concept

- Heilmann Park is the major catalytic park project for the City of Detroit's Strategic Neighborhood Fund (SNF) initiative for the Gratiot/7 Mile (G7) Neighborhood Framework Plan area.
- \$900,000 in CDBG funding with an additional \$900,000 of additional funding from the National Park Service Outdoor Recreation Legacy Grant.
- Total of \$1.8M for the Park
- Community engagement was done throughout 2022 and 2023 to understand the community's park priorities (update 7/2024)


