### RE: 2025-26 Homeless Solutions Funding Appeals Resolution

On Monday, May 12, 2025, Your Honorable Body conducted an Appeals Hearing for the 2025-26 Homeless Solutions Funding (HSF) program.

During the appeals process, the following organization appealed the Mayor's recommendation not to fund:

Based on its review and analysis, HRD recommended to City Council that the appeal be denied. At its meeting on May 15, 2025, the City Council voted that the appeal be denied.
