## CITY OF DETROIT MICHAEL E. DUGGAN, MAYOR NOTICE OF PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO HUD ACTION PLANS FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2020-21

Notice is hereby given that the City of Detroit, Housing and Revitalization Department (HRD) proposes to amend its U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Annual Action Plans for FY 2020-21 to reprogram and amend Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the accounts below to be used in FY 2024-25. This Notice is to allow citizens to review the descriptions of the activities and the year of funding that these activities will use.

The scope of the eventual construction project will include upgrades to the facility kitchen, renovation to two bathrooms for ADA compliance, and general façade improvements. <u>Covenant House (FY 2024-25) Matrix Code 03B</u> Public Facility Rehabilitation - Pre-development costs (Architect, Environmental Consultant, General Contractor Procurement). The scope of the eventual construction project will include renovations to multiple buildings in the Covenant House campus. This includes a boiler replacement and interior renovation at building one, office and laundry expansion at a second building, and roof replacements. <u>Coalition on Temporary Shelter (FY 2024-25)</u> Matrix Code 03B Public Facility Rehabilitation - Predevelopment costs (Architect, Environmental Consultant, General Contractor Procurement). The scope of the eventual construction project will include a roof replacement, boiler replacement, electrical upgrades, and foundation repair to its homeless shelter.
