



Thinking of Opening a Restaurant or Food Truck?

Make sure your plans are approved before construction begins



Here's what you have to do before construction starts to stay on track and avoid costly delays:



LEARN THE PROCESS

- Review the Detroit Health Department's approval requirements by visiting detroitmi.gov/foodsafety
- These rules apply for all restaurants, food trucks, bars or other establishments serving food
- Begin assembling all required materials to stay on track and meet Detroit Health Department guidelines



THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOUR PLAN IS APPROVED

- Submit your plans at least two months in advance
- Construction should not begin until the Detroit Health Department has completed its review
- If you are not opening a food truck, you need to submit your plans to the City of Detroit Buildings, Safety Engineering, and Environmental Department (BSEED). To learn more, please visit detroitmi.gov/BSEED
