

United Community Housing Coalition hosted the tenant council meeting at Clement Kern Gardens on Wednesday, May 28th from 4:00 – 6:00 pm. The event was held outside with food and drinks provided by UCHC and Detroit Parent Network.

UCHC invited the Detroit Parent Network to speak at the tenant council. In attendance were Anthony Young, who is the Parent Engagement Specialist, and Tracey Siebert-Rudolph, who is the manager of the Healthy Families program. Their mission is to support families in Detroit, with a focus on childhood literacy programs, supporting healthy families with a focus on social and mental health, advocacy through paid fellowship programs for parents, and different parent training programs. 
