

Recap of the Fenkell Avenue Corridor Action Plan Process

- Launched through the commitment and advocacy of Ms. Betty Varner and the DeSoto Ellsworth Block Association (D.E.B.A.), who elevated community priorities.
- Partnership with the Fenkell Business Association, led by Coach and Mrs. Sims, to represent corridor businesses.
- Coordination with the Department of Neighborhoods (DONs) and Detroit Economic Growth Corporation (DEGC) District Business Liaisons (DBLs) to align resources.
- Collaboration and strategizing with City departments and agencies to identify and confirm near-term implementation opportunities.
- Public transparency and resource sharing through the dedicated Fenkell Avenue Corridor website.
