Overall Progress Narrative:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded the City of Detroit, Housing and Revitalization Department \$95,228,000 in Community Development Block Grant- Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funding to support long-term recovery efforts following the 2021 Presidential Major Disaster Declaration (federal disaster declaration FEMA#4607-Michigan Severe Storms, Flooding, and Tornadoes).

This Quarterly Performance Report (QPR), due October 30, 2025, summarizes the progress of the City of Detroit CDBG-DR Program for July 1 – September 31, 2025. City of Detroit processed a voucher this quarter in the amount of \$93,388 as an Administrative Activity. After the quarter closed, the voucher was revised to five activities. The Financials field 'Total Funds Drawn' Administration is overstated, but the field for Total Funds Expended is correct.

The City of Detroit has made progress towards implementing the Disaster Recovery Program.

As described in the Action Plan, Detroit's aging infrastructure and older housing stock exacerbates the devastating impacts of extreme weather events, particularly on vulnerable communities. As these events become more frequent, city operations, businesses and residents will need to be better prepared and adapt to withstand these new climate conditions. As described in the Action Plan, the flood events of 2021 resulted in devastating impacts and a series of unmet needs which the planning study will further study. For hazards, like flooding, that are challenging to mitigate, the best course of action is to prepare and adapt to improve recovery time and overall resilience. The preliminary engineering analysis will evaluate the impact to converting a combined relief sewer to a stormwater sewer within the district to reduce the stormwater from entering the combined system. The data was reviewed multiple times a week to ensure the meters were inservice and recording reliable and accurate data.

DWSD provided an existing InfoWorks ICM model design event model that was reviewed by ASI. The existing InfoWorks ICM model was ran for a storm event that was recorded during the monitoring period. The model results were compared to the recorded meter data to identify areas of focus for the model calibration effort. The existing model was then then updated to more accurately represent the as-built manhole geometry. No community engagement meetings were held during this reporting period.

The program defines public facilities as projects that improve emergency shelters owned by nonprofits that are open to the public and receive referrals from Detroit's Coordinated Assessment Model (CAM). Funding and Program guidelines will further define eligible projects for applicants. Mitigation funds are included in the public facilities budget and will be used to support improvements to facilities that were not directly impacted by the flood event.
