Free Bus Rides to the Polls for Detroit Voters on November 4

Detroiters heading to the ballot box this fall will have one less obstacle to worry about: transportation. Detroit City Clerk Janice Winfrey has announced a partnership with the Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT) to provide free bus rides on Election Day, November 4, 2025.

"Every Detroiter deserves an equal opportunity to exercise their right to vote without barriers," Winfrey said. "Working with DDOT ensures that lack of transportation will not stand in the way of democracy."

The initiative will allow riders to board any DDOT bus at no cost on Election Day, ensuring that everyone—from voters traveling to the polls to residents heading to work, school, or other destinations, can move freely across the city.

This year's Municipal General Election is a pivotal one for Detroit. Voters will be electing candidates for the offices of Mayor, City Council, City Clerk, Police Commissioner, and Community Advisory Council. These races will help shape Detroit's leadership and policies for the next four years, from public safety oversight to neighborhood advocacy.

VOTING OPTIONS

Detroit voters have three convenient ways to cast their ballots in the November 4, 2025 Municipal General Election:

Absentee Voting: Voters on the permanent absentee ballot list should have already received their ballots. Completed ballots may be returned via secure drop box, by mail through the U.S. Postal Service, in person at the Department of Elections, or at any Early Voting Center.

Early Voting: Beginning Saturday, October 25, 2025, voters may cast ballots at designated Early Voting Centers across the city. Centers are open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through November 2.

Election Day Voting: On Tuesday, November 4, polling places will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for all registered voters.

Election officials are urging residents to plan ahead, bring proper identification, and take advantage of the free DDOT service if needed.

"This is about removing barriers and Detroiters," empowering Winfrev added. "When transportation is free and accessible, we make sure that every voice has the chance to be heard."

With the November 4, 2025, General Election fast approaching, it's critical for Detroit voters who received absentee ballots to return them as soon as possible. The Department of Elections anticipates a high volume of absentee ballots to be processed for the General Election. As such, we encourage those who vote by absentee, to return their ballots within 24 hours of receiving them.

Returning your ballot promptly not only helps the Department of Elections process it more efficiently but it also guarantees timely result reporting.

Upon completing your absentee ballot, please ensure that:

- You've filled out every section.
- Your ballot is placed inside the secrecy sleeve envelope.
- The ballot return envelope is sealed, signed, and dated, where indicated.

Then, return your absentee ballot immediately! This can be done either by mailing it back, by using one of the designated drop boxes in your area, delivering it to the Department of Elections or an Early Vote Center (see back page).

The stakes are high, and your voice matters. Don't wait until the last minute—return your absentee ballot right away. Every vote counts, and returning your ballot as soon as possible guarantees your participation in shaping the future of our city.

NON-PARTISAN ELECTION

TO VOTE: Completely darken the oval opposite each choice as shown:



IMPORTANT: To mark your ballot, use only a black or blue ink pen. DO NOT USE ANY OTHER INK COLOR!

DO NOT vote for more candidates than indicated under each office title.

WRITE-IN CANDIDATES: To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write or place the name of that candidate in the blank space provided and completely darken the oval. Do not cast a write-in vote for a candidate whose name is already printed on the ballot for that office.

CHECK BOTH SIDES OF BALLOT: This ballot has two sides. Be certain to check the reverse side of the ballot.

WHEN YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING: Place the ballot in the secrecy sleeve so that votes cannot be seen and the numbered stub is visible. Return the ballot to the election official stationed at the tabulator. (If voting by absentee ballot, follow the instructions provided by the clerk for returning the ballot.)

NOTE: If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the election official and obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to erase or correct any marks made in error.

ELECCIÓN NO PARTIDISTA

ভোট দেওয়ার জন্য: প্রতিটি পছন্দ মতো করে ডিম্বাকৃতি পুরোপুরি অন্ধকার করুন:
