The City of Detroit Buildings, Safety, Engineering and Environmental Department (BSEED) – Environmental Affairs (EA) Fugitive Dust Plan Environmental Review Requirements outlines requirements and obligations for dust-generating community establishments, including demolition, construction, and earth-moving activities. All requirements are pursuant to the existing Fugitive Dust Ordinance (Ordinance No. 2024-26, Chapter 8, Article XV of the City Charter, effective June 13, 2024).

Fugitive Dust Plans are required to be submitted to and approved by BSEED before any new demolition, construction, or dust-generating activities can begin. Additionally, a community establishment shall notify the Director of BSEED in writing of changes in operation or expansions at least 30 days before the expansion or change in operation occurs. BSEED maintains the ability to revise and/or approve Fugitive Dust Plans, as needed, and require additional fugitive dust mitigation measures to ensure compliance. Fugitive Dust must not exceed 5% opacity onsite and/or 0% opacity offsite. Violations may result in tickets or further corrective actions.

Fugitive Dust Plans can be submitted as part of a permit application and/or submitted directly to BSEED Environmental Affairs using the <a href="mailto:dust@detroitmi.gov">dust@detroitmi.gov</a> email. Requirements for a community establishment's Fugitive Dust Plan are detailed below:
