United Community Housing Coalition hosted the tenant council meeting at Clement Kern Gardens on Tuesday, September 30th from 4:00 – 5:30 pm. The event was held on the grounds of CKG. All residents were invited.

Tenant Organizers with UCHC spoke with residents to discuss any tenant issues, concerns and any other items they wanted to talk about. If residents have any questions about CKG and the development process, we encourage residents to attend the First Friday's to meet with IMS developers.

# **CKG Development Updates**

Q: What should residents living in CKG expect to see/hear in the final months of 2025?

A: ACD expects to begin demolition of CKG buildings 8 -12 by the end of 2025. Residents should expect to hear above average noise from excavators & bulldozers during regular work hours. Residents can also expect to see construction fences/ barriers, debris and/or dust near high traffic heavy equipment areas.

Q: When will construction of the new CKG development begin?

A: ACD expects to begin construction shortly after demolition has completed. CKG residents should see construction happening at the beginning of 2026 and thereafter.

Q: When will I know when it is time for me to relocate?

A: IMS will send out notices 6-months prior to any plans to relocate your household. You can expect several notices leading up to your actual relocation.



### Training - Pay me now, Pay me later?

Training and earning a certification is a big decision! Many people struggle with deciding. If you work now, you have an income. Many trainings do not have stipends so you may be without an income for a period of time.

If you can go through training and earn a certification, then get employed, the payoff can be big! You often go from a job to a career. You have more opportunities with higher earning potential. That's the "Pay later" option.

Some career training requires a different type of commitment. They offer classes off hours so you work and study at the same time. It takes longer to earn and can feel overwhelming at times, but that choice yields the same career path. That's the "Pay now."

To determine YOUR best option, think of the pros and cons. Evaluate how much you will earn when you complete the training. Is it worth the commitment? If you stop your income temporarily, what resources do you have to get you through? Will you need/do you have a support group?

A big factor is cost. Being part of CNI eliminates that issue. Take advantage of FREE training while there is still opportunity. Just pick a "now" or "later" plan!
