















DECORATIVE METAL PANELS:CUSTOM ELEMENT

- Custom designed metal panels with chosen theme elements cut and/or etched into panel to be secured over existing concrete.
- Metal color to match new guard rails for cohesive overall look.




SIDEWALK ART: SINGLE COLOR DESIGN FOR DURABILITY


- Simple sidewalk design element to coordinate with theme of custom metal panels.
- Extends reach of themes introduced in panels to additional areas of neighborhood.










Decorative Metal Panels Covering sections of the existing concrete overpass barriers.








- Engineered to AASHTO LRFD standards per Michigan Design Manual Bridge Design.




















VOTE: STICKERS	



- Moments of shade and relaxation featuring a bench, trash can, low-maintenance plantings, and a vertical wayfinding element.
- Benches would feature designs in alignment with overpass art.
- Vertical element would align with style/color of previously chosen wayfinding signage.

GREENWAY REST STOP + LIGHTING



 Vertical element may include programable lighting to amplify evening ambiance and align with special events.






