COVID-19 CASE RATE

The 7-day average rate of new confirmed COVID-19 cases among City of Detroit residents is 6.3 daily cases per million people as of 10/18/2025. This has decreased compared to the previous report, when it was reported as 9.2 cases per million people.

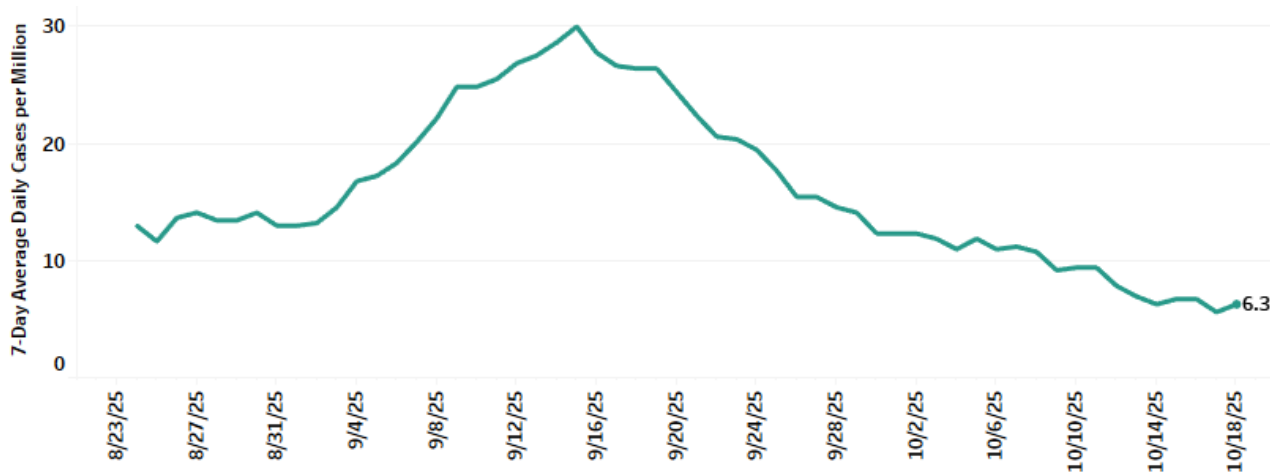


Figure 1: COVID-19 confirmed (daily/1,000,000) cases

There are 0.0% of Emergency Department visits in Detroit with diagnosed COVID-19 as of 10/18/2025.

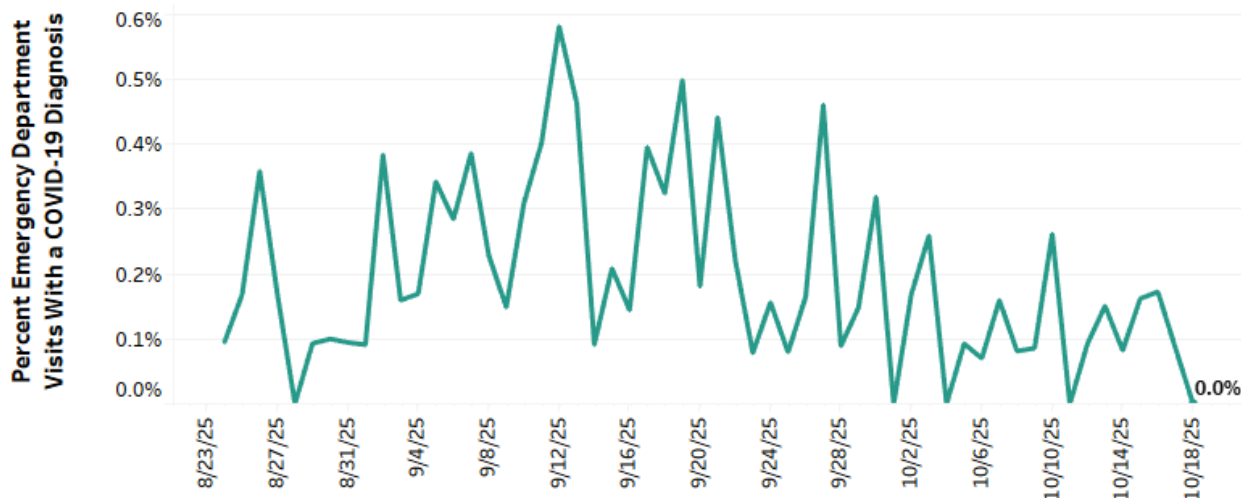


Figure 2: Syndromic Surveillance COVID-19 Diagnoses

There are currently 5 COVID-19 occupied inpatient beds and 2 COVID-19 occupied ICU beds recorded in the city of Detroit.

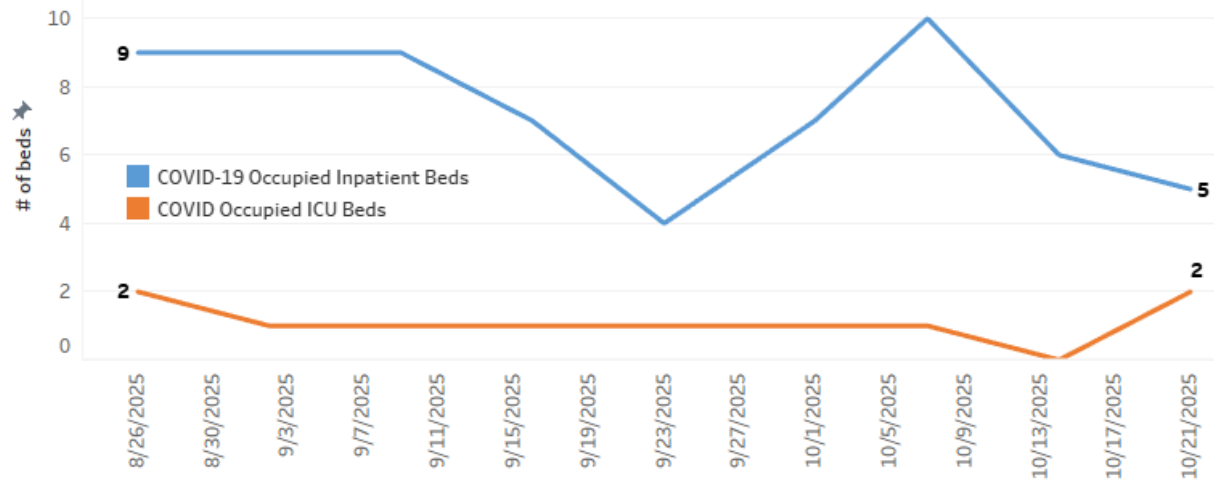


Figure 3: COVID-19 hospital occupancy
