Solid Waste Fee Increase: The City has implemented a Solid Waste Fee Increase starting in Tax Year 2024. Effective June 1, 2024, the City has enhanced its service by introducing weekly collections of curbside trash, recycling, bulk, and seasonal yard waste, along with weekly collections of debris from vacant lots. To accommodate these expanded services, the Solid Waste fee will undergo a \$10 increase annually for the subsequent three years, commenced in the summer of 2024.

August 15, 2025	Summer 1st Installment Tax Payment Due
August 31, 2025*	Summer Property Taxes Due
January 15, 2026*	Summer 2nd Installment and Winter Tax Payments Due
February 28, 2026	Final Tax Year 2025 Payment Due
March 1, 2026	Unpaid 2025 real property taxes become delinquent and are transferred to Wayne County Treasurer's Office

^{*}Pay by this date to avoid interest and penalties.
