ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

The City of Detroit Department of Public Works is making improvements to Randolph between Gratiot and Jefferson. The streetscape could include lighting, sidewalk improvements, traffic calming, utility work, landscaping, signage, pavement markings and site furnishings. The total estimated design and construction costs of this project is \$7.6 million. DPW anticipates construction to begin in March 2024 and to be completed in Fall 2024.





Project Scope Possibilities

 - Site furnishings.




Randolph Corridor Gratiot to E Jefferson





Current Street Configuration






Street Configuration Concept 1

Randolph - Monroe to E Fort










Proposed Parking Spaces 35


Proposed Parking Spaces 25
