Detroit Health Department Behavioral Health Program	Phone 313-938-3677	Services include needle exchange, free Narcan access and training, fentanyl test strips, and safe-use education. Harm Reduction Wellness Stations located throughout Detroit provide access to Narcan, test strips, condoms, and safe disposal bags. Outreach events also help connect residents to treatment and recovery services
Detroit Wayne Integrated Health Network (DWIHN)	24/7 Addiction Helpline 313-263-0077  Customer Service 844-615-2906  24-Hour Helpline 800-241-4949	Services include Recovery Oriented Systems of Care (ROSC), like outpatient and intensive outpatient treatment, detox services, residential care, early intervention, medication-assisted treatment, relapse recovery support, peer coaches, case management, and SBIRT (Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment)
Detroit Recovery Project	Phone 313-365-3100 or 833-DRP-HEAL	Provides outpatient treatment and prevention services designed to support individuals on their path to recovery
Henry Ford Outpatient Addiction Treatment	Phone 248-661-6100	Offers outpatient and residential treatment for substance use disorder. Services provide structured, supportive care either while living at home or in a treatment facility
National Overdose Prevention Lifeline	Phone 800-484-3731	Trained operators stay on the line to ensure emergency help is contacted in the event of an overdose
