Attached is the updated and possibly, final report of the 2017-2018 general fund budgeted appropriations, in Attachment I. The report is intended to give your Honorable Body an appropriation level, or legal spending limit, view of the status of general fund appropriations through June 30, 2018. This represents the financial activity of the past fiscal year. The report is based on data in the General Ledger as of September 28, 2018.

The actual expenditures total \$1.07 billion with a remaining balance of \$197.8 million. What is important to note as reported in Attachment III is the negative expenditures of \$47.8 million, when taken out, reduces the remaining balance to \$150 million.

Appropriations in Deficit as of January 2018 and Negative Encumbrances

Of the 168 appropriations in the general fund, 17 appropriations are in a deficit status as shown in Attachment II, which is seven fewer than last reported in January. This represent 10% of the total general fund appropriations. While these do need to be corrected and cleaned up, it does seem that the majority of them are due to improper charges and not departmental overspending. As an example, the City Council appropriation 00922 shows charges of \$10,478, but this is not even an appropriation that is currently in use by the Administration. The charges that were made were due to former employees who had become vested and able to apply for a pension. Subsequently their sick bank balances were paid out, and the department was told by the Payroll

Division in the Office of the CFO (OCFO) to charge the costs in that appropriation even though there is not a budget.

Since January, all negative encumbrances have been eliminated by the OCFO which is a positive step in cleaning up the financial records.

Both the City Charter and State law, have strict rules about not spending beyond budgeted appropriations at the appropriation level. This is concerning even if overall the city is projected to end the fiscal year with a surplus, as those expenditures were not authorized by the legislative body when the budget presented to them was approved. In the City Charter see Sections 8-212, 8-302, 8-303. Also pertinent is Michigan's Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act – Act 2 of 1968, Sections 141.438 – 141.440.

Alterations to the Budgeted Appropriations

Attachment IV is a table that shows specific appropriations reported in the city's financial system at certain points throughout the fiscal year. We ask the OCFO staff to explain the increases and decreases in these appropriations and documentation of Council Authorization regarding these changes.

We again would ask the OCFO staff what authority there was to amend the budget as we do not believe that all these amendments came before Council for authorization.

Questions to the OCFO.

- 1. Can the OCFO review Attachment II and indicate what the plan is to correct these appropriation deficits?
- 2. Can the OCFO review Attachment III and indicate what the plan is to correct the negative expenditures?

The Legislative Policy Division anticipates and welcomes Council Member's questions, concerns and suggestions on this report. We also request that the Administration respond to our concerns as laid out in this report.

RE: FY 2018-2019 36th District Court Budget Priorities

During the FY 2018-19 budget process, City Council raised concerns regarding the 36th District Court's policy to prohibit the public from bringing writing utensils into the building as the policy is demeaning and disrespectful to the very citizens and taxpayers who do business with the Court. In its closing resolution, City Council indicated that the Court needs to seek alternative means to address the vandalism and graffiti issues which prompted the policy by exploring the possibility of treating the murals with a protective coating, installing glass or similar clear covering over the murals in the building, or some other alternative. Lastly, City Council expressed its desire to see the prohibition on personal writing utensils rescinded and continued efforts made to promote a judicial environment that treats all members of the public with the dignity they deserve.

To that end, I am requesting an update on any efforts made by the Court to advance those budgetary policy priorities as outlined by City Council in its closing resolution. Specifically, what efforts have been made by the Court to protect its murals from defacement and rescind the writing utensil ban? Also, as requested by a memorandum from my office dated March 5, 2018, has the Court explored the possibility of installing temporary storage lockers on-site for visitors to store their cellphones and other prohibited personal items temporarily? Lastly, what is the status of the acquisition of polycom video conference equipment and the hiring of a part-time transporter using funds from last year's fund balance?
