





**RE:** Resolution in Support of the House Bill No. 4326 and expanding "Ban the Box" Legislation Statewide

I have been a vocal advocate for putting our citizens to work and creating job opportunities for Detroiters. Our returning citizens deserve a chance to find gainful employment without the impediment of the criminal history question during the application process.

On March 7<sup>th</sup> State Representative Cynthia Johnson introduced House Bill No.4326 also known as the "Job Applicant Criminal History Act." The bill would prohibit both public and private employers from inquiring about an applicant's criminal history during the application process. Enacting "Ban the Box" legislation on the state level would expand employment and employment training opportunities for Detroiters. Therefore, I am requesting that a resolution be drafted in support of House Bill No. 4326.
