The DPL is governed by a seven member Detroit Library Commission. Its public funding is provided primarily by taxpayers through a property tax millage 3.9943 on each \$1,000 of taxable value through June 30, 2025. Members are appointed by the Detroit Public Schools Community District Board of Education. In 2014, the citizens of Detroit voted to renew the tax millage. The estimated revenue raised by the millage**

was \$37,700,000.00. As evidenced by the testimony provided during the City Council's budget hearing for DPL, the revenues generated fail to meet the expenditure needs of DPL id library branch services were to be fully restored.)
