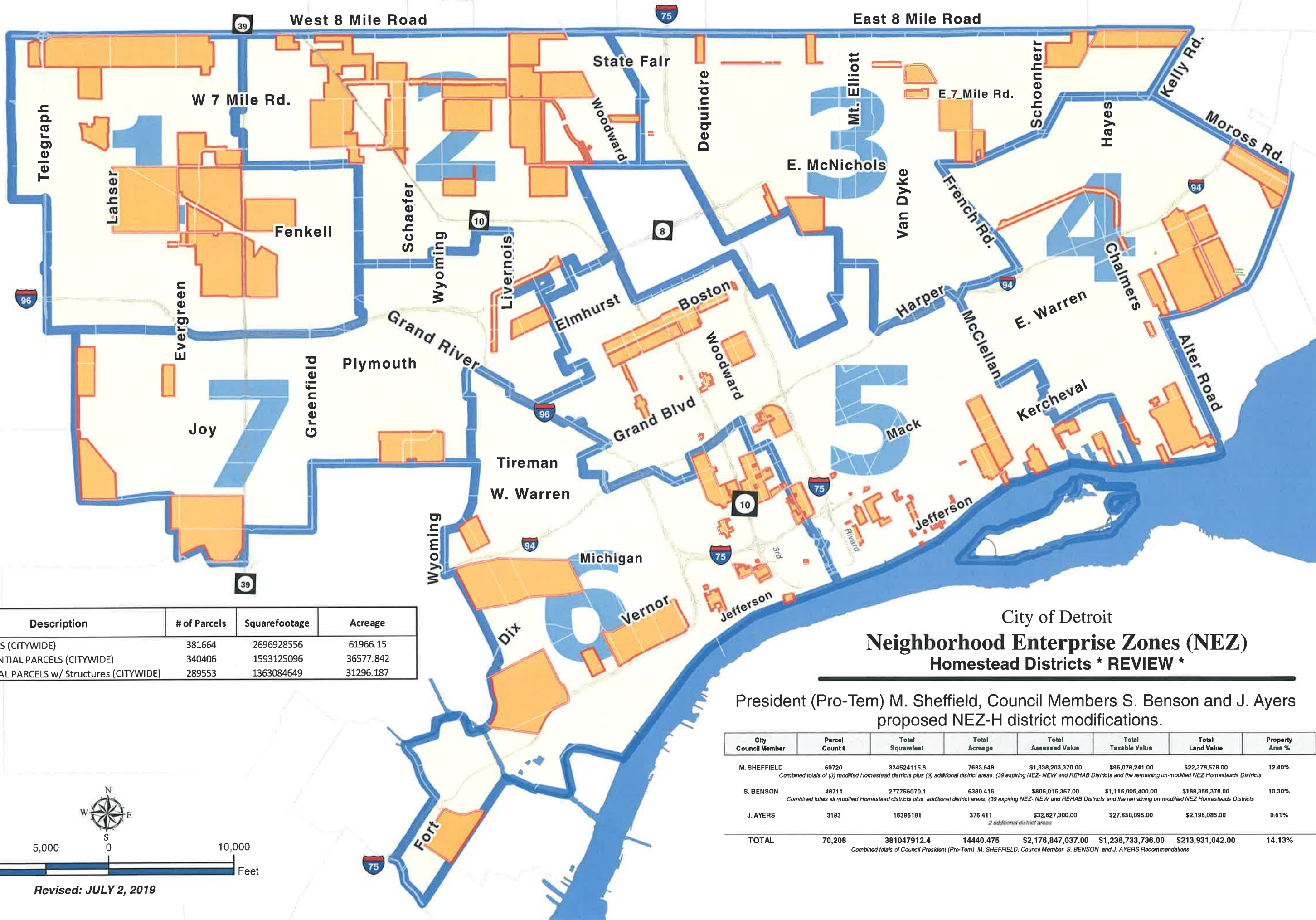
RE: NEZ HOMESTEAD (NEZH) UPDATED PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS

As council members engage the community and educate residents of the NEZ Homesteads, I urge you to keep in mind that the NEZs were created to stabilize neighborhoods. They are a powerful tool capable of both assisting in the revitalization of Detroit's middle class and retaining residency.

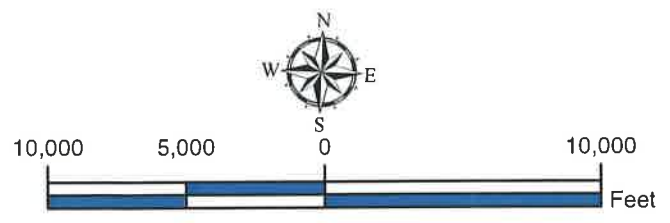
