to consider a text amendment that would amend Chapter 61 of the 1984 Detroit City Code, Zoning, by amending Article XII, Use Regulations, Sec. 61-12-241, and Article XVI, Definitions, Sec. 61-16-212, relative to youth hostels/hostels, for consistency with a proposed amendment relative to hostels in Chapter 44, Public Lodging, Article I, Definitions, and Division 2, Requirements Applicable to Public Lodging Houses, of the 1984 Detroit City Code.

The proposed Zoning text amendment would delete the 14 specified Article XII use regulations for hostels from the Chapter 61 Zoning Ordinance that are anticipated to being recited, revised, and expanded as part of the proposed amendment to Chapter 44, which regulates public lodging. The Zoning amendment would also state by cross-reference that the land use is subject to the requirements of the proposed Chapter 44 amendment. The definition of hostel is adjusted for consistency with the proposed definition in Chapter 44.

This text amendment is being considered by the City Planning Commission in accordance with the provisions of Article III, Division 2 of the Detroit Zoning Ordinance. Zoning Ordinance text amendments require the approval of the City Council after a public hearing and after receipt of a report and recommendation by the City Planning Commission.
