I am requesting an opinion from the Law Department on the following issues:

1. Is it lawful for a City of Detroit anti-poverty program, which is designed to reduce/eliminate an energy burden and the negative impacts of poverty on our residents by **utilizing general funds**, to make direct payments to utility companies on behalf of the residents?
2. If the above program is deemed illegal, would it be legal to **direct general funds** to an organization like THAW, who could then make direct payments to the utility companies to reduce/eliminate an energy burden and the negative impacts of poverty on our residents?
