the City Council by the Office of Chief Financial Officer

Before your Honorable Body is the FY 2021 Errata Letter that was recently presented to you by the Office of Chief Financial Officer (OCFO) to address the projected \$194.1 million revenue shortfall for FY 2021 as a result of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Attachment I represents the FY 2021 Errata Letter.

Parenthetically, City Council will recall that the City of Detroit is currently facing a projected \$348 million revenue shortfall for both FY 2020 and FY 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic: \$154.0 million for FY 2020 and \$194.1 million for FY 2021. Attachment II shows the proposed budget solutions for the FY 2020 and FY 2021 revenue shortfalls.

It is important to note that the Legislative Policy Division (LPD) reviewed the assumptions made by the OCFO to derive the projected \$348 million revenue shortfall, and we feel the assumptions are reasonable.

Usually, the purpose of the Errata Letter that is presented to the City Council during the budget process is to correct spelling and/or typing mistakes or to make non-substantive numerical changes and corrections to the budget. But the FY 2021 Errata Letter that is before you is highly unusual in that it is designed to address major changes in both revenue and expenditure appropriations to the Mayor's proposed FY 2021 budget presented to City Council on March 6, 2020 in order to address the projected revenue shortfall for FY 2021 and make other budgetary change.

Because of the enormity of the FY 2021 Errata Letter, LPD took a considerable amount of time reviewing the document. Attachment III represents responses from the OCFO to our questions on

the FY 2021 Errata Letter. We appreciate these responses. During Executive Session on Tuesday, April 28, 2020, the FY 2021 Errata Letter was discussed verbally with Council Members, and the OCFO addressed questions raised by your Honorable Body.

On pages 4 through 8 of 8 of the resolution component of the FY 2021 Errata Letter, City Council is asked by the OCFO to approve the increase and decrease of appropriations to the FY 2021 budget to maintain a balanced budget and address the projected \$194.1 million revenue shortfall for FY 2021.

Since City Council votes by appropriation regarding the City's budget, it was important to LPD to understand why the net (\$191.45 million) change to revenue and expenditure appropriations that did not agree with the \$194.1 million revenue shortfall figure. We subsequently found out that the net (\$191.5 million) change to revenues included other revenue budget changes as follows:

LPD is now comfortable with this reconciliation.

In addition, LPD tied the revenue and expenditure appropriation changes based on the above figures to the more detailed supporting schedules attached to the FY 2021 Errata Letter resolution your Honorable Body will be voting on. Using various spreadsheet iterations created by both LPD and the OCFO, we are now comfortable that the figures your Honorable Body will be voting on sufficiently tie to the supporting more detailed schedules.

More specifically, Council President Brenda Jones was concerned about the \$48,408 cut to City Council Administration FY 2021 budget. It turns out that the cut should be \$22,717 based on LPD's discussions with OCFO Budget concerning this issue. \$22,717 would represent a 2.5% cut to the Council Administration FY 2021 budget, which is consistent with the percentage cut to other City Council appropriations. This correction will be made whenever the OCFO presents an amended FY 2021 Errata Letter to City Council for consideration.

Lastly, there are three outstanding issues that will necessitate the need for the OCFO to present an amended FY 2021 Errata Letter to your Honorable Boday:

- City Council is considering a reduction to the FY 2021 budget for the Charter Revision Commission, based on a detailed review of their budget. City Council is awaiting for additional information from the Charter Revision Commission before making a final decision on the amount of the reduction to this budget.
- City Council is considering a reduction to the FY 2021 Police Towing Operatons special revenue fund budget. City Council is awaiting for more information from the Police Department before making this decision.
- City Council is considering postponing the implementation of outcome based budgeting
  for three agencies used as pilots in FY 2021: Department of Innovation & Technology,
  Fire and General Services Department. City Council is awaiting for additional
  information from OCFO Budget and LPD before making this decision.

#### Re: Changes to the FY 2021 – FY 2024 Four-Year Financial Plan

After further review of the Recommended FY 2021 – FY 2024 Four-Year Financial Plan the Mayor presented on March 6, 2020, significant appropriation changes are necessary to maintain a balanced FY 2021 budget. Those appropriation changes require an amendment to the Mayor's Recommended Budget. Outlined below is a summary of the circumstances that have led to the changes needed to the FY 2021 Budget.

Due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency and its mandatory business closures and impact on the national economy, the Office of Budget is projecting a \$194 million revenue shortfall in FY 2021 driven by:

- Gaming revenue losses directly tied to the casino closures on March 16, 2020
- Income tax reduction as employers have laid off and furloughed workers and there is a forecasted contraction in the national and state economy
- Anticipated State Revenue Sharing reduction due to a drop in state sales taxes
- Other revenue losses from suspended parking enforcement, bus fare interruption to protect drivers from COVID-19 and a reduction in business and construction permitting activity

The City is taking decisive actions to address the revenue shortfall:

- In early March, the Chief Financial Officer canceled all cash capital projects that were not yet under construction and all demolitions that were not an urgent life safety matter
- On April 3, the CFO issued a directive to freeze hiring and limit discretionary spending. Under this directive, departments were ordered to cancel discretionary contracts and purchases, make every attempt to limit overtime and limit new contracts to only those deemed critical by the CFO
- The Chief Procurement Officer is renegotiating contracts with major vendors to achieve savings
- The Mayor is eliminating new spending initiatives originally proposed in the FY2021 budget
- The City will ask authorities for cost savings measures to reduce appropriations
- To conserve reserves for operations, the Administration will reduce its demolition program in FY 2021 and eliminate a planned Rainy Day Fund deposit and a supplemental Retiree Protection Fund deposit
- The City is maximizing federal reimbursement for additional spending on COVID-19
- The City is instituting a number of workforce changes to reduce spending, preserve core City services, and treat employees fairly

The reductions to budgeted revenues and expenditures for FY 2021 impacting the General Fund are summarized below, along with a resolution for all appropriation changes. Detailed schedules of all changes at the cost center level and by category are attached. The changes also include revisions to the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department operating budget as approved by the Board of Water Commissioners.

### Questions on the FY 2021 Errata Letter from the Legislative Policy Division (LPD)

- 1. As we indicated to City Council, LPD is in the process of tying the numbers by appropriation, which we understand to be the net of any changes to that appropriation, to your supporting attachments. We will reach out to OCFO Budget if we run into any problems.
- 2. On page 2 of the cover letter of the Errata Letter, it is indicated that the FY 2021 revenue shortfall is \$194.1 M and that budget solutions equate to \$194.1 M. However, please explain why the total revenue shortfall is \$191.45 M and the total expenditure decrease to address the revenue shortfall is also \$191.45 M, and not \$194.1 M.

The \$194.1M revenue shortfall is the revenue loss with General Fund impact. These items are flagged as "April 2020 Revenue Shortfall Projection" on the Summary of Changes by Category (pgs. 1 and 2 of 6 in that section).

The \$191.45M is the overall net change in the revenue budget for all funds, inclusive of the projected revenue shortfall, various budget solutions that impact the revenue budget (e.g., use of Rainy Day Fund, changes in inter-fund transfers), the BOWC budget changes, and other savings that have a revenue offset. The summary below crosswalks the \$194.1M shortfall to the \$191.4M net change in revenue budget for all funds:

3. Please provide the position cut detail in total and by Department that makes up the \$29.3 million of Workforce Savings (Executive Branch) for FY 2021. How many positions are: layoffs; 80/20 cuts; and other?

4. Since the Casinos are expected to be shut down, what expenditure cuts are being made to police and fire for the loss of the municipal service revenue for FY 2021? What is the total municipal service revenue expected to be lost in FY 2021?

The City collects 1.25% of the adjusted gross receipts (but no less than \$4M annually) from each casino as municipal services fees. While the City imposes municipal services fees to assist the city in defraying the cost of hosting the casinos, there is not an automatic linkage between the amount of revenue collected and police and fire expenditures.

We are projecting an \$8.1M revenue loss in FY 2021 in municipal services fees (shown on Summary of Changes by Category, row labelled "06925 - Non Dept Casino Site Support & Infrastructure Improvement," pg. 1 of 6 in that section). This revenue loss reflects projected losses in adjusted gross receipts at the 3 casinos from March 2020 through December 2020. Municipal Services Fees are accrued based on annual cycles from the casinos' anniversary dates, which shifts the losses occurring now to FY 2021.

5. Why are the CAFR auditing fees down \$300,000 for the OAG in FY 2021? Why would audit fees be diminished by COVID -19?

The City's auditing firm has agreed to reduce fees by \$300,000, which will provide savings for the City.

6. When the City is better able to assess and determine the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on the City's revenues and expenses will the OCFO further amend the FY 2021 budget? Will there be any further FY 2020 and FY 2021 Budget amendments based on the State of Michigan's May 2020 Revenue Consensus Conference? Will there be any further FY 2021 Budget amendments based on the City of Detroit's Revenue Estimating Revenue Conference?

The OCFO will continue to monitor and manage the City's revenues and expenses. The OCFO will recommend additional budget amendments as needed, including any resulting from State activity. As in past years, the OCFO is conducting its annual May Revenue Review, which will serve as an update to the April 2020 projected revenue shortfall, and may inform subsequent budget amendment recommendations. The City will hold its next Revenue Estimating Conference in September 2020.

7. What is the total amount of CARES Act dollars does the OCFO anticipate receiving from the Federal Government to be used offset the revenue loss in DDOT operations in FY 2020 and FY 2021? Has the City received any of these dollars for DDOT?

The OCFO anticipates DDOT will receive over \$60M from the emergency transit grant in the federal CARES Act. The Errata Letter includes using this grant to offset \$6M in FY 2020 fare losses, \$10M in FY 2021 fare losses, and \$20M in reduced City General Fund contribution. The remainder will be set aside for capital and preventative maintenance needs.
