COMPSTAT- ORIGIN

- Compstat –shortened from Compare Statistics, is a bi-weekly meeting dealing specifically with crime and command accountability. It was developed in the 1990s at the New York Police Department to help reduce crime. It was found to be an effective way to accurately track crime and use the information to deploy officers to address it in timely manner.

COMPSTAT- DPD

- Meetings held on a Bi-Weekly basis.
- Members from all precincts and specialized commands are present.
- Process is constantly evolving in an attempt to keep the reviews relevant and timely.
- Focus is on patrol response and scene investigations to incidents. Also, the investigative follow-up to reported crimes.

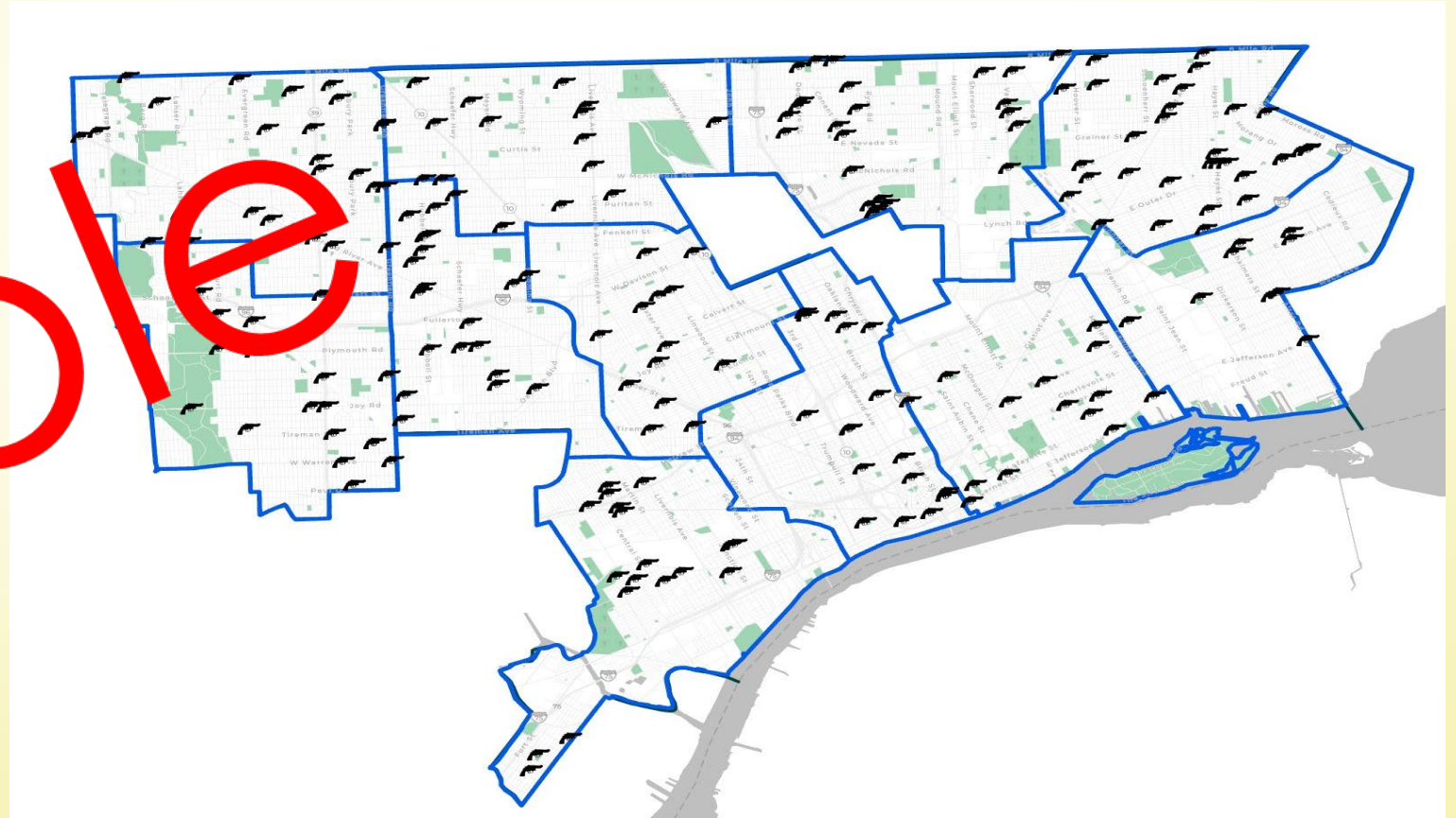
Compstat - Focus

YTD Citywide Robberies

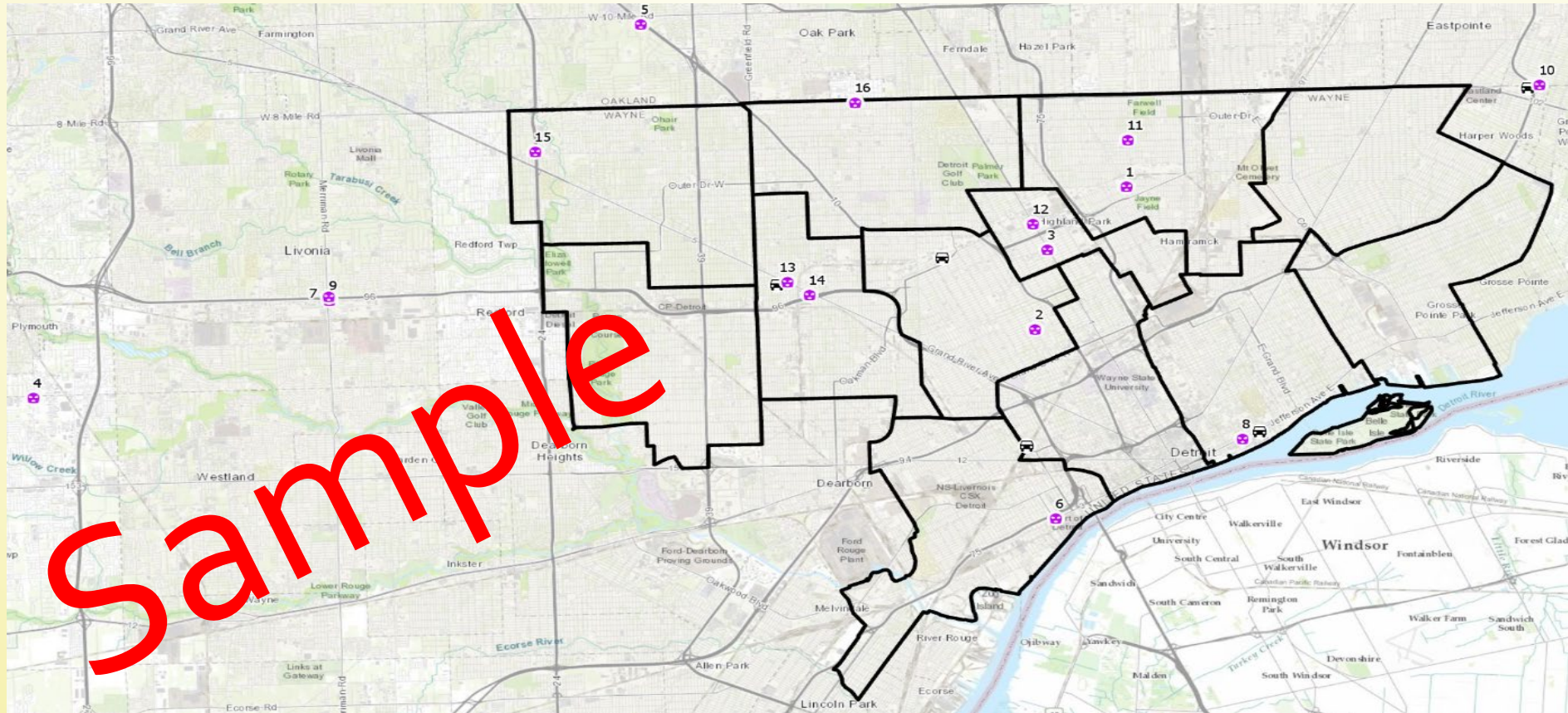
