

**RESOLUTION HONORING
COMMANDER KYRA J. HOPE**

WHEREAS Kyra J. Hope was appointed to the Detroit Police Department on April 4, 1987. Upon graduating from the Detroit Metropolitan Police Academy, Officer Hope began her career at the First Precinct; and

WHEREAS Officer Hope's assignments with the Detroit Police Department included the First Precinct, Narcotics Section, and Chief's Staff Division; and

WHEREAS Officer Hope displayed tremendous knowledge and leadership skills as a Police Officer and was promoted to the rank of Investigator on July 6, 1995. As Investigator, she was reassigned to the Chief's Staff Division and also served at the Liquor License Unit, Narcotics Special Operations, and Fifth Precinct Investigative Operations Unit. On March 21, 1997, Investigator Hope earned promotion to the rank of Sergeant and was reassigned to the Fifth Precinct Investigative Operations Unit, Narcotics Special Enforcement Section, Gang Enforcement Section, and Central Service Surveillance Unit; and

WHEREAS Sergeant Hope was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on September 17, 2003 and was assigned to Twelfth Precinct, Western District, and Community Liaison. On March 17, 2014, Lieutenant Hope was appointed to the rank of Captain and served at the Seventh Precinct and Chief's Neighborhood Liaison. Captain Hope was appointed to the rank of Commander on September 21, 2020. Commander Hope was reassigned to the Chief Neighborhood Liaison, where she served until her retirement; and

WHEREAS Commander Hope was the deserving recipient of the following awards: Chief's Unit Award, two Chief's Unit Awards, five Perfect Attendance Awards, Ford Fireworks Award, both Consent Judgment Awards, Major League Baseball All-Star Recognition Award, Rosa Parks Funeral Recognition Award, Super Bowl XL Recognition Award, and Aretha Franklin Funeral Recognition Award, as well as numerous letters of commendation from citizens and superiors; and

WHEREAS Commander Hope has tirelessly served the Detroit Police Department, the citizens of Detroit and its neighboring communities for 35 years. She has served the Detroit Police Department and the citizens of the City of Detroit with loyalty, professionalism, integrity and dedication, and is widely respected throughout the law enforcement community as the consummate professional.
