## Some vital facts about the 4<sup>th</sup> Precinct:

- ▶ The Fourth Precinct is located at 4700 W. Fort Street just west of Clark Street. We share a building with the Detroit Fire Department
- ▶ The 4<sup>th</sup> Precinct is approximately 14.41 Sq. miles. With a population of about 67,000 citizens.  
Bounded by: North: W. Warren Ave. West: Dearborn, (Wyoming) Melvindale (Schaefer), Lincoln Park (Outer Drive) River Rouge (Campbell St.) and East (14<sup>th</sup> St, Newark, Michigan Ave. and W. Grand Blvd.) See map.

## We have a number of unique programs/resources for our Citizens

- ▶ Our CIT (Crisis Intervention Team) Car
- ▶ Officers and a Civilian Social Worker trained to handle police runs involving unsheltered citizens, citizens in crisis, mental health runs and drug addiction related runs.
- ▶ WAVE Project: Every Tuesday, the WAVE project provides showers, clothing, and food to our unsheltered population in the 4<sup>th</sup> Precinct, at Clark Park and at Kemeny Recreation Center. This project was brought to our precinct by our CIT Officers.
- ▶ Community Justice Center, and Community Court,
- ▶ CJC provides resources to our citizens, from drug addiction help to obtaining a drivers license. Also assist citizens sentenced to community work through the Community Court.

## We have a number of unique programs/resources for our Citizens

- ▶ 80 Green Light locations in the 4<sup>th</sup> Precinct, with 7 in the pipeline
- ▶ Domestic Violence Advocate embedded at the Fourth Precinct, assisting victims of violence apply for Personal Protection Orders
- ▶ Work closely with the Gordie Howe Bridge construction company to coordinate and share information on construction updates and road closures due to the construction.
- ▶ Community Relations Meetings the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday at 6PM of each month at the precinct.
- ▶ NPO's and Command Staff attend numerous Community Block Club meetings each month.

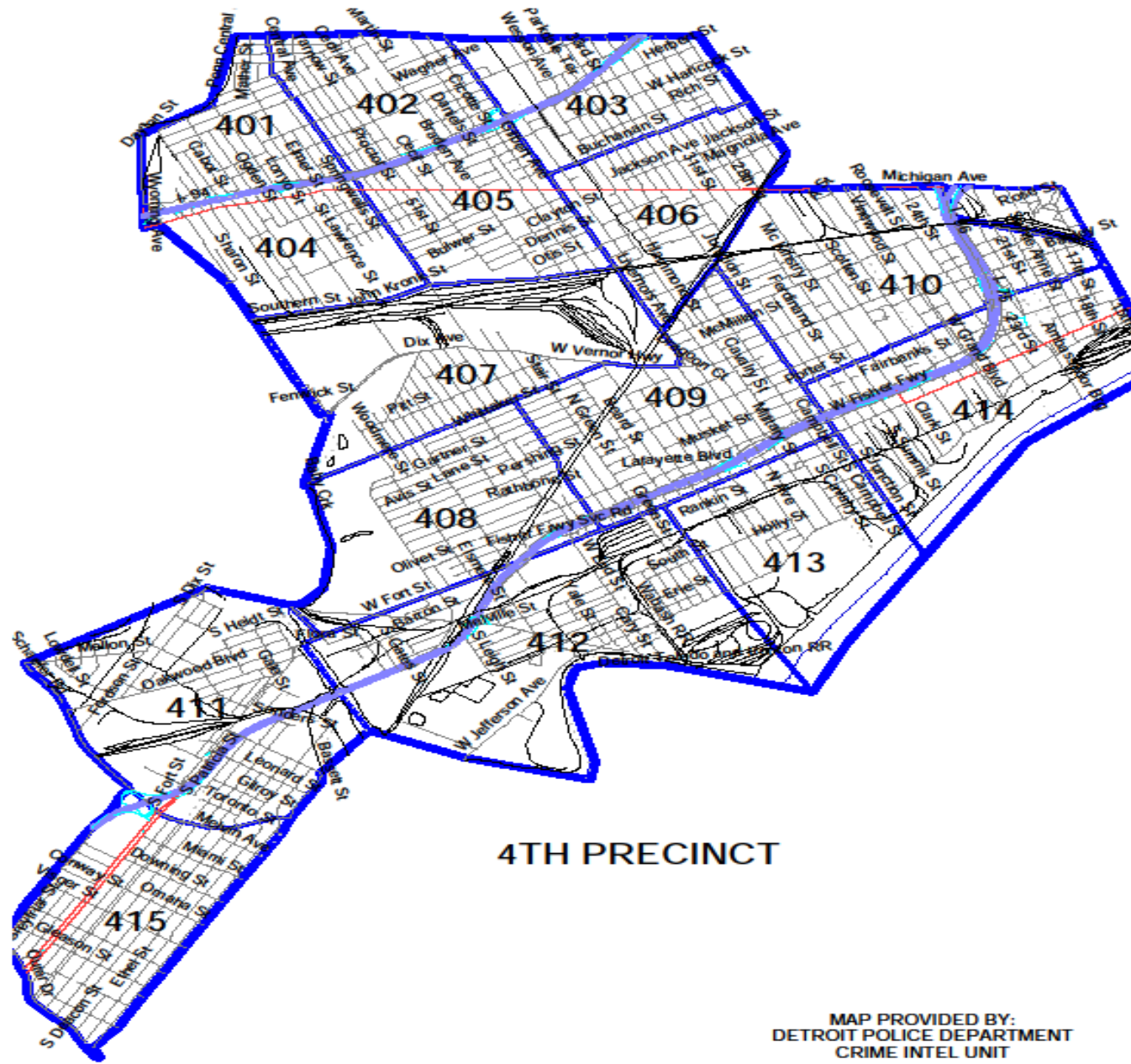


# Crime Trends in the 4<sup>th</sup> Precinct
