WHEREAS Tarran Foster was appointed to the Detroit Police Department on October 13, 1997. Upon graduating from the Metropolitan Police Academy, Officer Foster began his career at the Eleventh Precinct; and

WHEREAS Officer Foster dutifully served the Eleventh Precinct, Southeastern District, Housing Support Division, and Special Response Team, before being promoted to the rank of Sergeant on August 1, 2014, and assigned to the Fifth Precinct, and the Training Academy. On Sunday, December 25, 2022, Sergeant Tarran Foster, badge 0667 passed away; and

WHEREAS During his law enforcement career, Sergeant Foster was the deserving recipient of a Chief's Merit Award, Chief's Unit Award, Chief's Citation Award, Military Service Award, both Consent Judgment Awards, the Major League Baseball All-Star Recognition Award, the Rosa Parks Funeral Recognition Award, the Ford Fireworks Award and the Super Bowl XL Recognition Award, and numerous letters of commendation from citizens and superiors; and
