UNDER REVIEW: Expanding DPD Use of License Plate Surveillance

The Board of Police Commissioners is reviewing DPD's request to spend \$5 million to expand its use of License Plate Readers (LPRs) to help prevent auto thefts and apprehend crime suspects. DPD and Municipal Parking currently use LPRs. The **new** DPD request involves surveillance with high-speed cameras, automated image detection, and other technology. The review is part of BOPC's civilian oversight role and its work for the 2021 City Ordinance for Community Input into Government Surveillance.
