## Some Key Points on Proposed Revisions for Officer-Involved Shooting Investigations Policy 205.11

### Trends for OIS and Investigations

- What is the five-year trend in OIS and the related OIS Investigations
  - Number of suspects/civilians shot by police officers
  - Number of police officers shot in the line of duty
  - Outcomes of OIS investigations by category (charges, rulings, etc.)

### The Public's Need to Know

- What information should be released to the public during OIS Investigations
- Should all video related to OIS be released to the public and what criteria would govern such releases
- Should the Homicide Task Force make a public report on all concluded OIS investigations

### DPD Policy Revisions and Community Goals

- Is anything standing in the way of community-led changes -- such as state laws or collective bargaining agreements

### Not sure what to say during the hearing?

- Ask questions or share concerns you have about Officer-Involved Shootings and how the policy might address your questions or concerns
- Say what you want to have OIS investigations tell the public or not tell the public
- Share if you support the proposed changes or not
- **Remember:**  
The public hearing is specific to the proposed policy and changes. Be familiar with the policy.
- Public Hearing comments are limited to **two minutes**.
- The Board Agenda still has Oral Communications/Public Comments for items not related to the public hearing.
