- **Public Hearing:** Expanding DPD Use of License Plate Reader (LPR)/Surveillance Technology

*The Board of Police Commissioners is reviewing DPD's request to spend \$5 million to expand its LPR use to help prevent auto thefts and apprehend crime suspects. DPD and Municipal Parking currently use LPRs. The new DPD request involves surveillance with high-speed cameras as well as automated image detection and other technology. The public hearing is part of BOPC's civilian oversight role and its work on the 2021 City Ordinance for **Community Input into Government Surveillance**.*
