SUBJECT: BOPC REQUEST FOR REPORTS OF THE DISCIPLINARY OUTCOMES FOR OCI SUSTAINED CASES (FEBRUARY)

Members of the Board of Police Commissioners (BOPC) requested the disciplinary outcomes for sustained Office of the Chief Investigator's (OCI) cases.

As a result, I directed the Disciplinary Administration leadership to provide the BOPC with the requested information, on a monthly basis.

Please see the following table of fully adjudicated OCI cases from February 1, 2023 through February 28, 2023 (there were 25 cases adjudicated):

¹ The penalties were Written Reprimands. The cases were received from OCI 365+ days after the incident occurred. Therefore, the penalties could not be issued as per the collective bargaining agreements, so they were Administratively Closed for timeliness.
