**SUBJECT: BOPC REQUEST FOR REPORTS OF THE DISCIPLINARY

Members of the Board Police Commissioners (BOPC), requested the disciplinary outcomes for sustained Office of the Chief Investigator's (OCI) cases.

<sup>1</sup> The penalty was a Written Reprimand. The case was received from OCI 366+ days after the incident occurred. Therefore, the penalties could not be issued as per the collective bargaining agreements, so they were Administratively Closed for timeliness.
