Citywide Summary

Within the past 28-days, the city experienced an overall decrease in violent crime categories. **Precincts 6 and 7** – mostly as a result of aggravated assaults and homicides. **Most notably, all precincts (with the exception of 12**th **Precinct) showed reductions in Homicies)**. Aggravated Assault number overall decreased within most precincts (with the exception of 4th, 7th and 8th Precincts). This is a contradiction to the overall trending numbers for this year as it relates to aggravated assaults (one of the crime categories that have been steadily increasing throughout the year. When looking at **robbery numbers, numbers have increased significantly for most precincts – this is to be expected during holiday season**. However, there were still several precincts that showed significant decreases for this crime category – 2nd, 3rd, 7th and 9th Precincts. When looking at year-to-date numbers, however, robbery has shown strong decreases amongst all precincts. Again, **many of these violent crime cases were gun-related**, with a gun being present or shots being fired in both aggravated assault and robbery cases.

Keeping with the overall trend of this year, property crime continues to decline for this 28-day period – with the exception of 2nd precinct, which showed a year-to-date increase of 11% while all other precincts showed significant decreases of 20+ precent. Citywide, there has been large decreases in burglary, larceny and stolen vehicle cases, when comparing year-to-date numbers. Though there were significantly more Burglaries and Larcenies than we have seen in previous months, overall citywide numbers for both crime categories still show a particularly large decrease. This December was has reported the lowest overall property crime, when comparing to the last 5 years. This is the first month of the year where all precincts have reported a decrease in damage to property cases – one of the crime categories that have been trending upwards for the majority of the year. Again, most of these cases were gun-related.
