On behalf of the Board of Police Commissioners Special Personnel & Training Committee, please see the key updates from the committee meeting held on November 8, 2024:

**Sec. 7-805. Chief of Police Search**: The Board of Police Commissioners shall conduct a professional search with a reputable and qualified executive search firm or other equally qualified entity to identify candidates for Chief of Police. The Mayor shall appoint, subject to approval by City Council, a Chief of Police from a list of qualified candidates provided by the Board of Police Commissioners

On November 1, 2024 the Office of Procurement sent out the advertisement for the search firms to reply. As of November 6<sup>th</sup> the Office of Procurement received four responses: 1. Korn Ferry a Los Angeles Company (35% retainer fee). 2. TJA Staffing a Southfield Company (30% retainer fee. 3. JMJG Connect a Detroit Company (30% retainer fee). 4. Capstone Employment Services a Detroit Company (15% retainer fee}. After thorough review of each search firm previous experiences, retainer fees, their ability to shortlist candidates, and their ability to have a process between 60-90 days, the Special Personnel & Training Committee made a recommendation for TJA Staffing to the full board for consideration.

The next Special Personnel & Training Committee meeting date and time to be determined.
