### **PROPOSAL SUMMARY**

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded the City of Detroit an additional \$95 million under the Disaster Recovery Program (CDBG-DR). This award is specifically for aiding Detroit in long-term recovery from the June 2021 presidentially declared disaster, and mitigating the risk and impact of future disasters. During this meeting, Housing and Revitalization Department (HRD) will provide an overview of Disaster Recovery Action Plan allocations and program updates.

- Private Sewer Repair Program is increasing the number of neighborhoods that qualify for assistance.
- Establishes project details for the Infrastructure Mitigation Project
- Details the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) Application eligibility requirements for Public Facilities Improvement and Affordable Rental Housing Program.
