Action Item: The BOPC Committee, through Chairperson Linda Bernard, moved and approved three proposed policy directives for a vote at the next full BOPC Board meeting. Minor revisions were discussed and agreed upon by all parties for the following three directives:

- Directive 102.12: Duty to Intervene
 - Section 102.12-3.1 (Intervene) was revised to include "or personal harm to any individual."
- Directive 201.2: Patrol Related Reports
 - Section 201.2-4.1, number 3 (Arrest Report), was revised to add "applies."
 - Section 201.2-4.3, number 2 (Other Arrests), was revised to add "any."
- Directive 401.1: Performance Evaluation Rating
 - Section 401.1-3.4 (Civil Rights Integrity) was revised to include "and sustained citizen complaint records."
- Safe Surrender Policy: Discussions regarding the Safe Surrender Policy were postponed until the next meeting on April 15, 2025.
