

## **Resolution Honoring Sergeant Willie Robinson**

- WHEREAS** Sergeant Willie Robinson began his career with the Detroit Police Department on July 8, 2008. Upon graduating from the Police Academy, he was assigned to the Northeast District as a patrol officer. On his very first day, he wrote his first moving violation—and from that moment, a passion for traffic enforcement was born. It didn't take long before a traffic legend was in the making; and
- WHEREAS** Recognizing his interest and skill in traffic enforcement, Sergeant Robinson quickly became radar- and lidar-certified. In 2018, he took on one of the department's most challenging programs—the Harley-Davidson Motor Course—and successfully became certified as a motor officer. His dedication and drive led to his appointment in December 2016 as the official Motor Man of the 7th Precinct; and
- WHEREAS** Over the years, Sergeant Robinson has built an impressive record. In 2024 alone, he issued over 2,500 moving violations, responded to over 300 traffic accidents, made more than 30 arrests, and led the precinct in Operating While Impaired (OWI) arrests. His efforts have also resulted in the recovery and impounding of numerous improperly registered or uninsured vehicles, contributing significantly to public safety; and
- WHEREAS** On May 12, 2025, his leadership and performance were recognized with a well-earned promotion to Sergeant. In his new role, he continues to lead by example.
