This is your neighborhood. Your voice matters. Let's reimagine the road together.

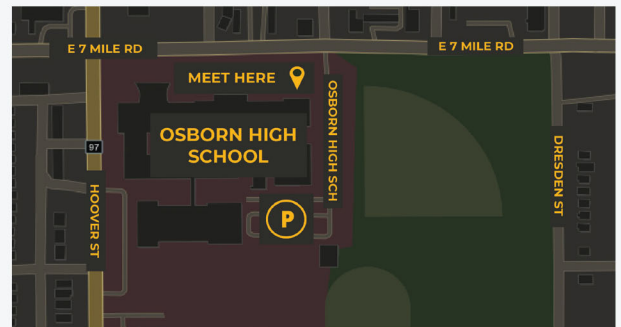
