The Missing Persons Unit is responsible for the following:

- Long Term Missing Cases
- Suspect Foul Play
- Amber Alerts
- Abduction/Kidnappings
- Unidentified Human Remains
- Vulnerable Missing's (age, mental disability or physical disabilities)
- Special Circumstances (Witnesses to crimes, recent domestic violence victims, etc.)
- Providing Training
- Identify and submit cases for Forensic Genetic Genealogy (FGG) testing

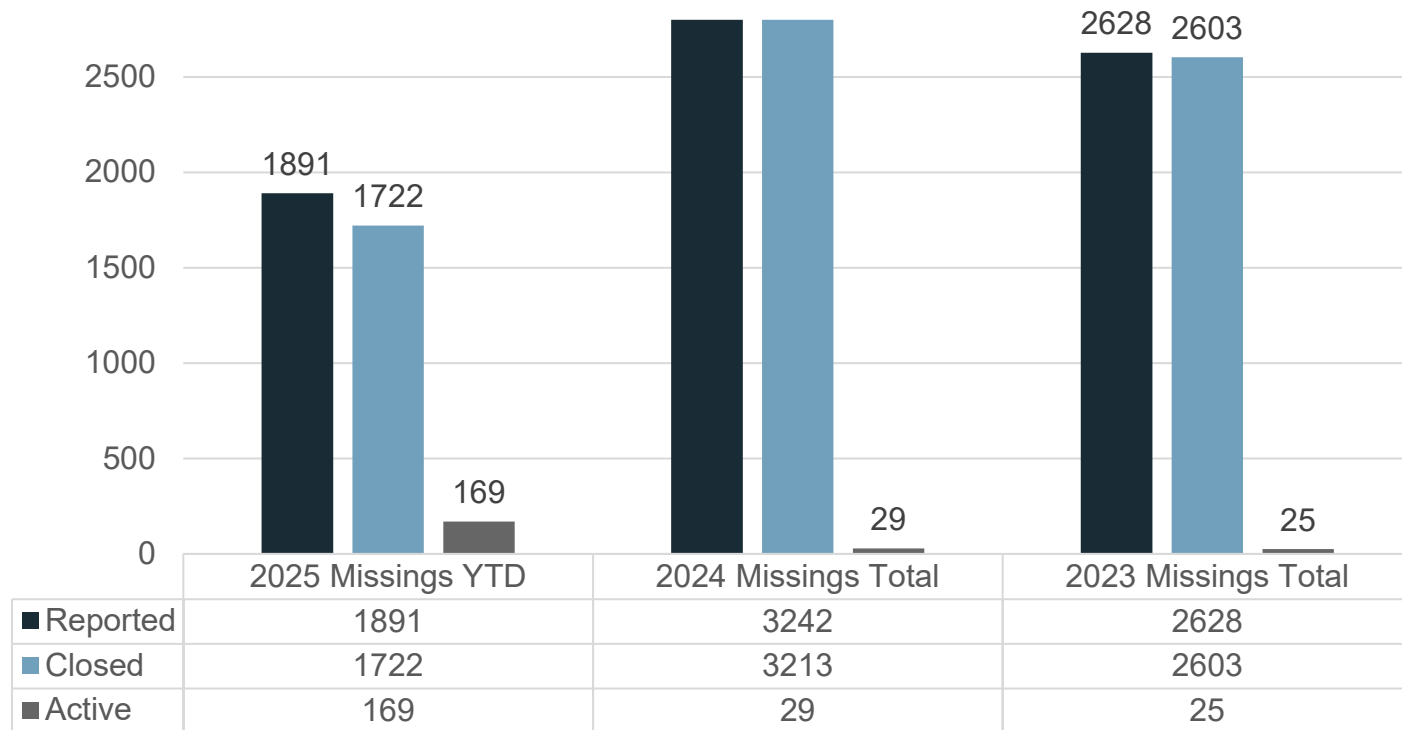

CASE DEMOGRAPHICS BY AGE

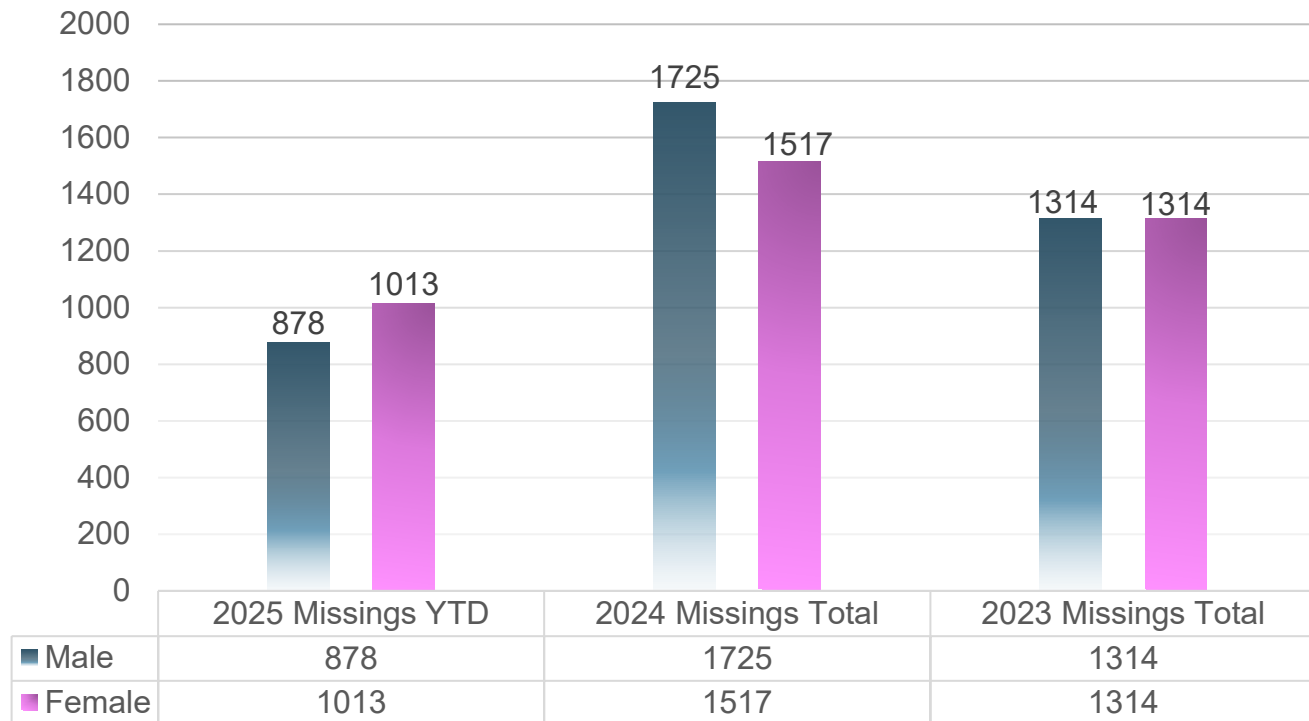
Missing Persons Breakdown 2025 YTD

As of August 18, 2025, 1,891 Missing Persons reports have been filed. 1,722 have been closed for an overall closure rate of 91%.



CASE DEMOGRAPHICS BY GENDER



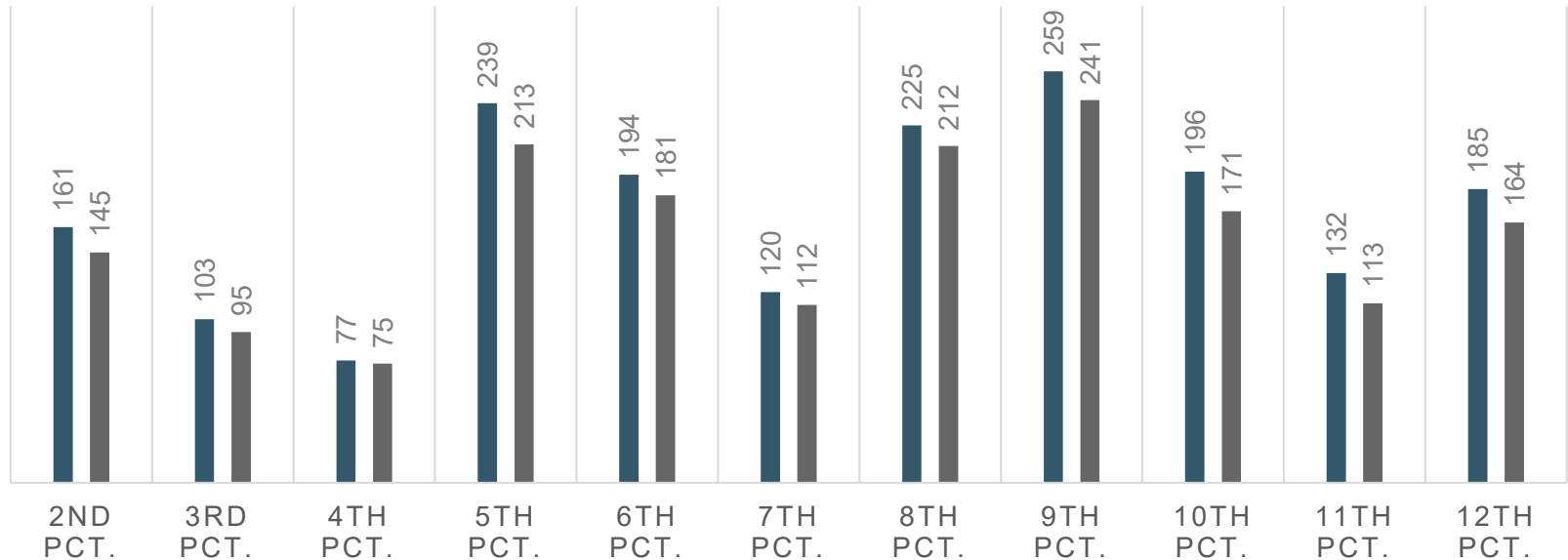
■ Male ■ Female

■ Total Cases ■ Closed



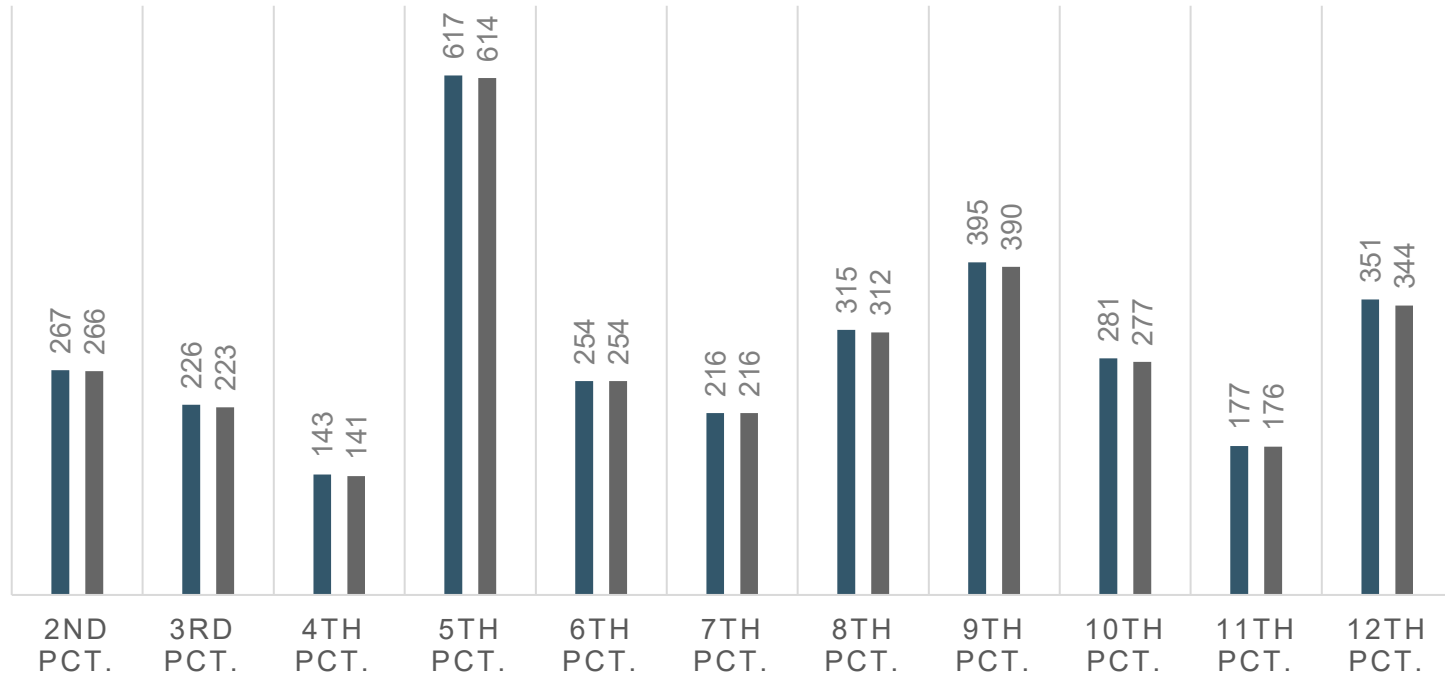
The overall closure rate for missing persons cases 2025 is 91%

CASE HIGHLIGHT-LONDON THOMAS

- Identified Suspects for London Thomas
- Executed multiple search warrants, reviewed multiple hours of video data, examined cellular data
- Coordinated Mass Multi Agency searches resulting in recovery of London Thomas in Southfield MI (ruled a homicide by Oakland County ME)
- Case continued with Michigan State Police
