**Retired Lieutenant John Campbell**

**WHEREAS** On September 12, 1974, John Campbell began his distinguished career with the Detroit Police Department, and upon graduating from the Detroit Metropolitan Police Academy, he was assigned to the Second Precinct (Vernor Street); and

**WHEREAS** Throughout his career, Officer Campbell served with dedication and professionalism in multiple assignments, including the Narcotics Section, the Eighth Precinct Detective Unit, Internal Controls, and the Seventh Precinct Detective Unit; and

**WHEREAS** On July 1, 1994, he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant, where he continued to demonstrate exemplary leadership in the Ninth Precinct Patrol Unit, the Ninth Precinct Detective Unit, and the Crime Prevention Unit; and

**WHEREAS** On August 23, 1999, he was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant and returned to the Crime Prevention Unit, where he played a vital role in advancing crime deterrence strategies and fostering proactive policing initiatives; and

**WHEREAS** On June 1, 2002, Lieutenant John Campbell honorably retired after more than twenty-eight years of dedicated service to the Detroit Police Department and the citizens of the City of Detroit; and

**WHEREAS** Throughout his tenure, Lieutenant Campbell exemplified integrity, commitment, and unwavering service, earning the respect and admiration of his colleagues and the community he served; and
