Retired Sergeant Michael Greene**

**WHEREAS** On January 26, 1987, Police Officer Greene joined the Detroit Police Department, and upon graduating from the Detroit Metropolitan Police Academy, he was assigned to the Fourth Precinct, later serving in Gang Enforcement and the Mounted Unit; and

**WHEREAS** On May 4, 2001, Officer Greene was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and assigned to the First Precinct, and during his supervisory career, he also served in Internal Controls, a division responsible for maintaining the integrity of Department personnel and investigating allegations of misconduct; and

**WHEREAS** Throughout his distinguished career, Sergeant Greene was the recipient of numerous honors and commendations, including the Major League Baseball (MLB) All-Star Game Award, the Rosa Parks Funeral Award, the National Football League (NFL) Super Bowl XL Award, as well as various departmental citations and ribbons, reflecting his professionalism, dedication, and commitment to duty; and

**WHEREAS** On February 4, 2012, Sergeant Greene retired after more than twenty-five years of loyal and dedicated service to the Detroit Police Department and the citizens of Detroit; and

**WHEREAS** Sergeant Greene's career exemplified integrity, leadership, and an unwavering commitment to public safety, leaving a lasting impact on his colleagues, the Department, and the community he faithfully served; and
